



Scenery & Excitement on the North Umpqua River

The Umpqua River & Steamboat Inn

July 14th - 15th

with Ouzel Outfitters

Famous for towering firs, crystal clear water, wild-run steelhead and breathtaking scenery, the North Umpqua River is one of the crown jewels of Cascade Mountain streams. Through narrow gorges and boulder-choked passages the Umpqua delivers plenty of class III rafting action. The rafting action builds to an exciting climax at class IV Pinball Rapid towards the end of the second day. The combination of exciting rafting, dramatic Cascade Mountain scenery and remote luxury lodging and fine dining is a uniquely Oregon experience.

Over the course of two days, we'll paddle 25 miles from Boulder Flat Campground to Susan Creek Campground with one night of comfortable lodging and exquisite dining at historic Steamboat Inn. Combine this excursion with a side trip to nearby Crater Lake National Park or spend an extra day at Steamboat and explore the many waterfall hikes in the surrounding Umpqua National Forest.

What's Included

Two full days of exciting rafting with gourmet riverside lunches. River travel is by paddle raft. Paddle jackets and pants or wetsuits are provided as conditions necessitate. Accommodations, dinner and breakfast at historic Steamboat Inn. Pick-up and drop off at the Steamboat Inn each day.

Trip Itinerary

We meet at the Steamboat Inn at 10:00 a.m. on our first day. From here we'll travel a mile to our put-in at Gravel Bin boat launch. Today we'll raft the 12 mile section from Gravel Bin to Susan Creek Campground, passing by the Steamboat Inn early in the day. We'll return to Steamboat this afternoon where you can check into your cabins. A wine and cheese social is held this evening in the library prior to dinner. After breakfast the following morning we'll depart Steamboat at 10:00 a.m. for our launch location at Boulder Flat Campground. Today we'll paddle 13 miles from Boulder Flat to Gravel Bin. We've saved the upper (and more exciting) section for the second day. We'll return to Steamboat Inn by 5:00 p.m.

Accommodations at Steamboat Inn

We have reserved 8 Streamside Cabins and 1 River Suite at the Steamboat Inn. Accommodations are on a first-come, first-served basis and pricing is based on double occupancy. Additional options may be available for larger groups or singles – please call our office for more information.

The Streamside Cabins are carpeted and pine paneled, with comfortable furnishings, private baths, and spacious decks overlooking the North Umpqua at its most magnificent. Fine photographs, interesting prints, hand quilted comforters and Vermont Castings gas stoves complement these one room cabins. *8 Cabins Available*

The River Suites combine the luxury of the hideaway cottages and the views of the Streamside Cabins. Each river suite features a large living room with fireplace, mini-kitchen, soaking tub overlooking the river, king size bed, private deck, air conditioning and other amenities that add up to the best of everything!
