CHIHUAHUA WOODS PRESERVE

Chihuahua Woods has been designated as a site on the Great Texas Coastal Birding Trail, and with sightings such as clay-colored robin, hook-billed kite and black-tailed gnatcatcher, the preserve has become a favorite birding stop. Access is walk-in only, daylight hours only. The marked trail is approximately 1 mile. You are welcome to explore, but please stay on obvious roads or trails. As with any natural area, please respect the resource: "Take nothing but pictures, leave nothing but footprints." Also, be aware that cactus and thorns are abundant, so sturdy leather shoes or boots are advised. No restroom facilities are available, but Bentsen-Rio Grande Valley State Park is only a few miles away. For more information, please call 956/580-4241. Happy birding!
