

Vascular Plants of Love Creek Preserve, Bandera County Texas

This list combines all plant taxa reported by the senior author in his master's thesis (Denny, 2002) and by the junior author in an informal list of the flora of the Love Creek Ranch (Carr, 2001), a slightly largely property from which the preserve was subdivided in 2000. In the "source" column, taxa reported by Denny are indicated by 1, and taxa reported by Carr are indicated by 2; those based on a Denny specimen and a Carr annotation are indicated by 1 -> 2. The number 3 indicates plant taxa observed on the Love Creek Ranch by Carol Adams in the 1980's or 1990's but not subsequently encountered.
