Baraboo Hills Land Stewardship Intern

Learn about land stewardship and help manage preserves in the Baraboo Hills this summer!

Work in the field alongside Conservancy staff and gain hands-on experience in invasive species management, boundary posting, easement monitoring, GIS, prescribed fire, volunteer engagement, and more. This is a 12-week paid summer internship based in Baraboo, WI.



Door Peninsula Land Stewardship Intern

Work outdoors and get to know some of the most ecologically important landscapes in Door County! Visit and monitor natural lands owned by TNC or under conservation easement. You'll also have the opportunity to work with partner organizations and Conservancy staff on invasive species management, trail maintenance, and other key land stewardship activities. This is a 12-week paid summer internship based in Sturgeon Bay, WI.

Northeast Wisconsin Outreach and Engagement Intern

Are you interested in community outreach and climate resilience? Help us engage East River watershed communities in a multi-year project to improve resiliency to flooding and other climate impacts. You'll help develop outreach materials, represent TNC at neighborhood meetings, communicate with partners, and prepare guidance for increasing equity and accessibility in the lower watershed. This is a 12-week paid summer internship with work throughout the East River Watershed in the Green Bay area.

Mukwonago Land Management Intern

Spend your summer doing hands-on outdoor work in the Mukwonago River Watershed! Help preserve habitat quality by assisting with land stewardship projects, rare species mapping, and insect monitoring. You'll also work on water-related projects such as conducting public outreach about aquatic invasive species and monitoring boat recreation. This is a 12-week paid summer internship based in East Troy, WI.
