## **Frozen Sun Catcher Activity**

## For this activity, you'll need:

- Nature's treasures (twigs, leaves, berries, pine cones, feathers, etc.)
- Container to freeze water in
- Water
- Hanging string (twine, yarn, ribbon)
- Drill (optional)
- Freezer space or freezing temperatures

## **Directions:**

- 1. Spend a few hours outside gathering up some naturetreasures such as twigs, leaves, berries, pinecones and more.
- 2. Put all the items into a container and add a few inches ofwater.
- 3. Leave the container outside (or pop into the freezer!) to freeze overnight.
- 4. Once frozen, pry the ice disk out of the container. Use your drill (optional) to make a hanging hole.
- 5. Hang your ice sun catcher in a spot where you can enjoy it sparkling in the sun.
