




Complete your contact information and date of the visit. This information is required in order to submit your report.



While geolocating a hazard, use the circle icon and zoom in to place the blue icon on the correct location. At this point in time, we only have the capability to capture one hazard location per report. If, for instance, you see more than one downed/hazard tree, geolocate the tree farthest from the trail entrance and report how many other downed trees are along the way in the box above. You'll have the ability to delete a hazard location and photo(s) to replace it with new ones you find further along.
