Priorities:

➤ **Phase out fossil fuels:** We must accelerate the equitable phaseout of fossil fuels to achieve net zero by 2050 or sooner and transition to renewable energy.



➤ **Invest financial flows towards people, climate and nature:** We must mobilize USD 1.3 trillion for nature-positive projects, policies and practices.



➤ **Build climate-resilient societies:** We must empower groups who steward nature to secure their homes, livelihoods and futures.



Recommended actions:

Support the implementation of ambitious NDCs

Implement NDCs and NAPs by increasing renewable energy and nature-based solutions to reduce emissions, improve resilience, and tackle the climate and biodiversity crises.

Deliver the USD 1.3 Trillion Baku to Belém Roadmap

Expand innovative financial mechanisms such as the Race to Belem, LEAF, TFFF, Nature Bonds, Project Finance for Permanence, credit enhancement, and redirecting inefficient subsidies, insurance and debt reform to increase public and private climate finance.

Halt and reverse forest loss and degradation by 2030

Increase finance for forests, improve land-use governance, enhance transparency, enforce laws and promote deforestation-free trade.

Catalyze finance and procurement for the food system transformation

Invest in low-carbon, sustainable agriculture and aquaculture transitions that avoid habitat conversion, promotes traceability and supports regenerative practices.

Deliver the UAE-Belém Work Programme

Use robust nature-positive indicators across all global adaptation targets, driving increased ambition and strengthening resilience.

Enhance Direct Finance to Indigenous Peoples and Local Communities

Provide IPLCs with direct, accessible and equitable funding that supports their self-determined priorities and strengthens territorial stewardship.

Ensure community voices shape climate policy

There must be progressive and actionable outcomes for the Lima Work Programme Gender Action Plan, the Just Transition Work Programme and the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform.

Grow the bioeconomy

Support locally-led, sustainable economies that create jobs, generate income, value Indigenous and local knowledge, drive community well-being, conserve and restore biodiversity, and enhance carbon stocks.

Scale up action on Loss and Damage

Accelerate access and operational modalities for the Fund for Responding to Loss and Damage and Santiago Network to bolster critical financing, technical assistance, and project delivery support for climate-vulnerable communities.
