


Volunteer Role Open:

The **Data Entry Specialist** will process volunteer service records into our global database. Your assistance will help TNC centralize its volunteer program in Indiana, create more searchable records for more staff to access, and help the volunteer program run more efficiently.

The volunteer will get to learn a new CRM database skill, network with TNC staff, and add much appreciated support to our Inspiring People for Nature volunteer program.

Duties may include:

- Uploading batches of volunteer service hours records into our CRM database
- Creating volunteer profiles in our database and linking to current volunteer waivers
- Sorting and organizing volunteer service records
- Adding volunteer hours to service tracking documents
- Decoding handwritten emails for newsletter signups and digitizing them
