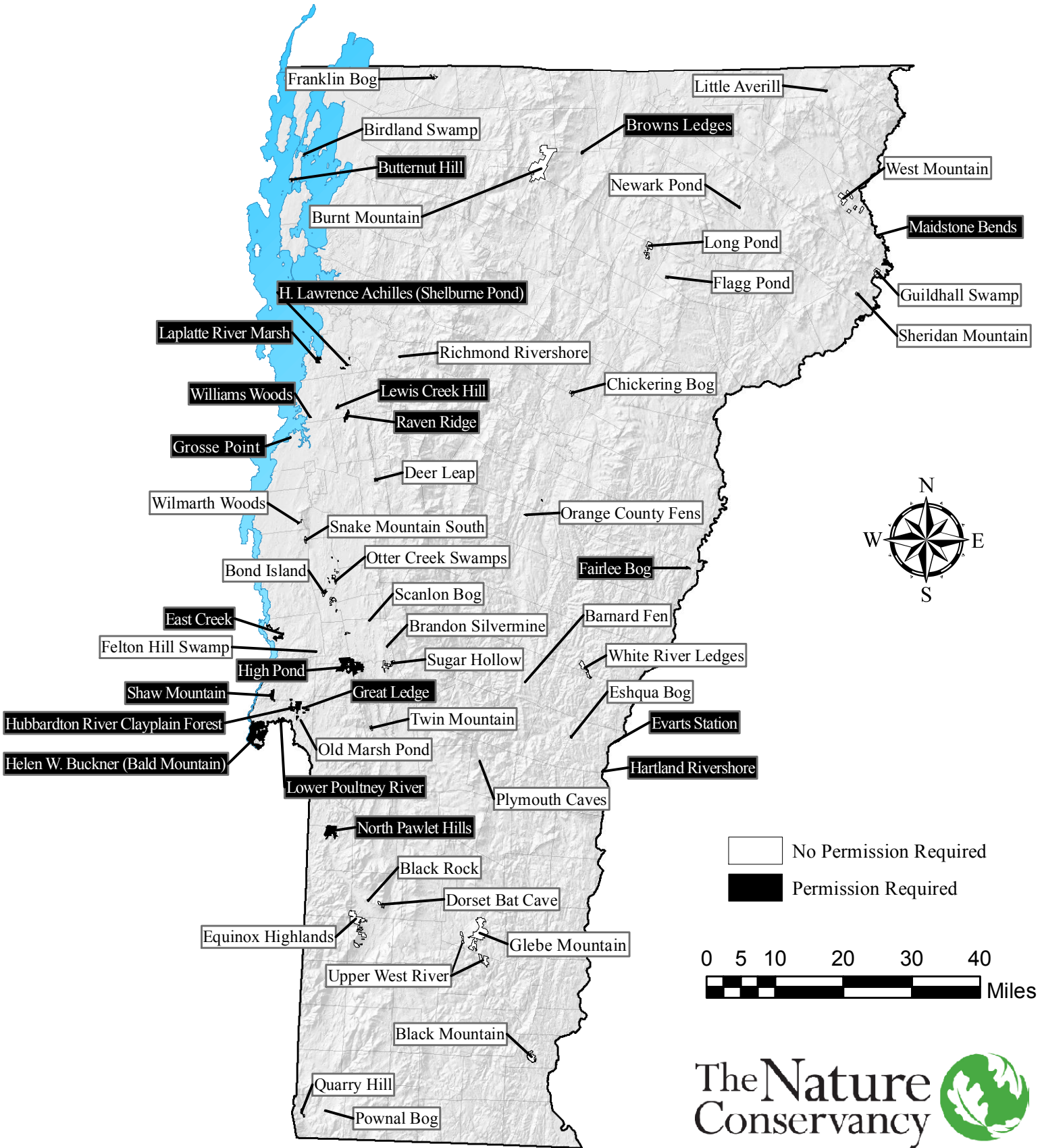

- ◆ Hunting of predator species including black bear, bobcat, gray and red fox, coyote, marten, lynx, ermine, otter, fisher and mink is generally **prohibited**
- ◆ **Temporary** tree stands and ground blinds are allowed from the third Sunday in August through the third Saturday in December, May 1-31 or during any Youth Hunting Day or Youth Hunting Weekend
- ◆ No damage may be done to vegetation in erecting stands and blinds and they must be clearly labeled with owner's name and address
- ◆ Permission may be granted at the discretion of the natural area manager for single working dogs under direct voice command for upland bird or waterfowl hunting
