RAMSAR COP15

The Nature Conservancy calls on parties to:

ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT THE FIFTH STRATEGIC PLAN:

- → Agree on robust and quantifiable targets for the protection, restoration, and effective management of Ramsar sites and associated freshwater biodiversity, aligned with the Global Biodiversity Framework and the Global Goal on Adaptation.
- → Identify and validate a pathway for the development of key indicators, with leadership from the STRP.
- → Include in the Plan adequate means of implementation at global and national levels, in particular financing.
- → Recognize the rights of and engage with local communities who steward wetlands and their biodiversity for their lives and livelihoods, including fisheries.
- → Mainstream wetlands and nature-based solutions into plans for climate mitigation and adaptation, land and aquatic food systems, energy, and infrastructure.

RAISE LEVELS OF AMBITION FOR THE PROTECTION, IMPROVED MANAGEMENT, AND RESTORIATION OF RAMSAR SITES AND OTHER WETLANDS:

- → Recognize the Freshwater Challenge as a mechanism to strengthen the implementation of the Ramsar Convention for freshwater ecosystems.
- → For each Ramsar site, establish dedicated governance and funding mechanisms and to adopt or update management plans.
- Prioritize Ramsar sites and other wetlands in the expansion and improved management of national systems of protected and conserved areas towards 30x30.
- → Adopt and implement legal, policy, and administrative measures and direct new resources to achieve the goals and commitments under the Ramsar Convention.
