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Southern Vermont:

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- ♦ Hunters should seek permission from private landowners if crossing private land to access TNC land.
- ♦ Hunting of predator species including black bear, bobcat, gray and red fox, coyote, marten, lynx, ermine, otter, fisher and mink is generally **prohibited**
- ♦ **Temporary** tree stands and ground blinds are allowed two weeks prior to gray squirrel season until two weeks following the end of deer season, May 1-31, or during any Youth Hunting Day or Youth Hunting Weekend.
- ♦ No damage may be done to vegetation in erecting stands and blinds and they must be clearly labeled with owner's name and address
- ♦ Permission may be granted at the discretion of the natural area manager for single working dogs under direct voice command for upland bird or waterfowl hunting
