

MAURICE RIVER BLUFFS BIKE TRAIL RULES

NO HIKING ON BIKE TRAIL. Please use the preserve's other trails for hiking and jogging.

ONLY RIDE ON OPEN TRAILS. Please, respect trail closures and areas set aside for animal and plant protection. Do not trespass on private property.

LEAVE NO TRACE. Stay on existing trails and do not create new ones. Do not build new features or alter existing ones. Give the trail time to dry after rain. Pack out what you bring in, especially refuse.

CONTROL YOUR BICYCLE. Ride within your limits. Where possible, there are ways around technical features. Please, if needed, use them. If something makes you nervous, walk it. Trail riding can be dangerous, so it's up to you to keep yourself safe.

YIELD TO OTHERS. Try to let other trail users know you're coming. A bell or a greeting will usually suffice. Bicyclists traveling downhill should yield to those going up. Try to make each pass courteous and safe.

NEVER SCARE ANIMALS. Please, give any animals you encounter time and room to adjust to you. This property is for protecting animals and plants first.

PLAN AHEAD. Know your ability, your bike, and the area you are riding, and prepare accordingly. It's recommended to bring tools and supplies for flats. Always wear a helmet and appropriate safety gear.

This trail was built and is maintained by volunteers. Help keep it going by practicing environmentally sound and socially conscious trail riding. Have fun, and be safe.
