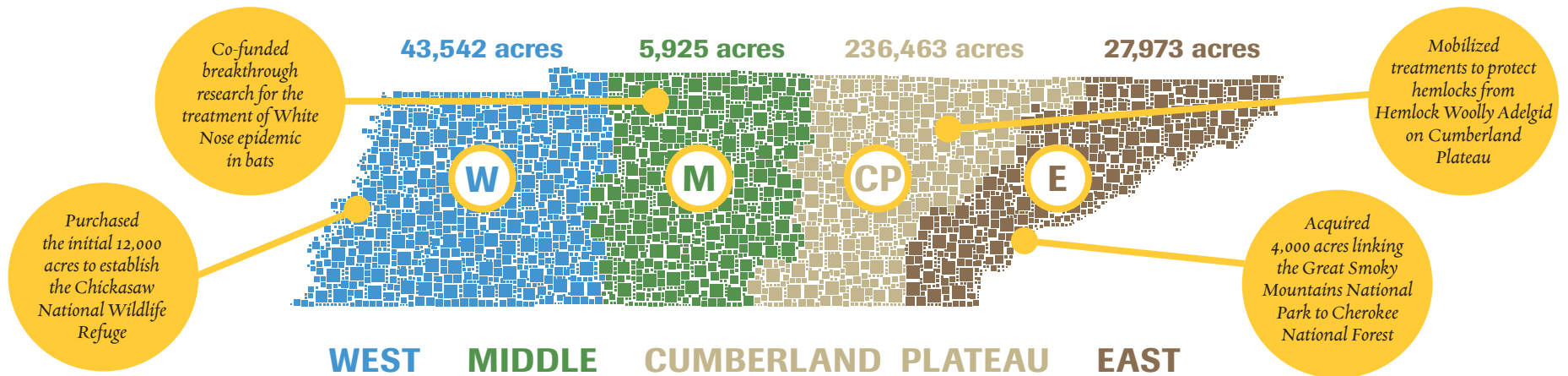

43 public lands in Tennessee created or expanded by The Nature Conservancy:

29 **State Natural Areas**
Including Walls of Jericho, Savage Gulf, Frozen Head, Radnor Lake, Pogue Creek Canyon, Couchville Cedar Glade

12 **State Wildlife Management Areas**
Including North Cumberland WMA, John Tully WMA, Skinner Mountain WMA

2 **National Wildlife Refuges**
Lower Hatchie and Chickasaw National Wildlife Refuges
